



# Waxing

Waxing is a form of hair removal which removes the hair from the root.

**This ritual has become a customary practice for both men and women**

seeking a safe and cost-effective way to temporarily remove unwanted face and body hair.



## FACE & BODY WAXING

**Facial Waxing** removes unwanted hair easily and thoroughly from Brow, Cheek, Chin and Lip areas. The most common waxing service, Eyebrow Design, opens and accentuates the eyes.

**Body Waxing** removes unwanted hair easily and thoroughly from arms, legs, chest, stomach and back leaving skin smooth to the touch. Hair must be  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch long for successful results. Performed in a private treatment room.

**Brazilian and Bikini Waxing** are a personal waxing service that have become a staple grooming essential for many modern women. The most notable difference is the gentler type of wax used and the option to decide how much hair you wish to remove. Your service will be performed in a private treatment room with proper draping. *Guests must be 18 years of age or older to receive Brazilian Bikini/Maintenance waxing services.*

**Nostril and Ear Waxing** safely and painlessly eliminates embarrassing nose and ear hairs instantly. This is our most popular Men's waxing service.

### BENEFITS

- Lasts longer than shaving because it pulls hair from the roots
- No cuts or nicks that can leave you with scars
- For many, waxing makes the hair grow slower and finer
- Will make your skin feel smoother longer without feeling itchy, because of slower hair regrowth
- Fast and convenient

## CONSIDERATIONS

There are conditions, cosmetic ingredients and medications that can cause skin sensitivity. Sensitive skin is more vulnerable to lifting during waxing.

- Sunburned or irritated areas cannot be waxed.
- After a light chemical peel or microdermabrasion, wait a minimum of seven (7) days before waxing.
- After laser skin resurfacing, wait a minimum of one (1) year before waxing.
- After a physician administered peel, wait a minimum of (2) years before waxing.
- Moles, Herpes or areas of question cannot be waxed.
- If you are diabetic with poor circulation or slow healing, waxing is not recommended.
- Women may experience extra sensitivity to waxing the week prior to and during menses. It is not recommended to receive a Bikini or Brazilian wax during this time.

Please inform your technician if you are currently using any of the following:

- Alpha Hydroxy Acids (Glycolic, Lactic)
- Oral Antibiotics
- Topical Antibiotics
- Retinol
- Salicylic Acid
- Exfoliants

## RX MEDICATION CONTRAINDICATIONS

If you are currently using any of the following prescription medications, you **cannot** receive a waxing service. You must discontinue use of these medications for a minimum of three (3) months prior to waxing. The exception is Accutane which is a minimum of one (1) year prior to waxing.

- Accutane (Acne medication)
- Adapalene (Acne medication)
- Alustra (Retin A)
- Avage (See Tazorac)
- Avita (See Retin A)
- Differin (Acne medication)
- Isotretinoin (See Accutane)
- Renova (See Retin A)
- Retin A (Acne and Anti-aging medication)
- Tazarac (Acne medication)
- Tazarotene (See Tazorac)
- Tretinoin (See Retin A)

## POST-TREATMENT

- No sun for 12 hours following a waxing treatment.
- No hot baths for 24 hours following a body waxing treatment.
- No abrasives for 24 hours following a waxing treatment.
- No deodorants for 24 hours following an underarm waxing treatment.
- If irritation should occur, use an antibiotic ointment such as Neosporin to avoid infection and keep the area lubricated.



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
