

# EYEBROW MICROBLADING

1) **What is Microblading for Eyebrows?**

A semi-permanent tattoo performed by a licensed tattoo artist using a hand tool outfitted with a configuration of micro-needles. The tool is used to create each individual hair stroke to create a natural and realistic eyebrow by depositing pigment into the dermis.

2) **Is Kelsey Anderson a Simonson's Salon & Spa employee?**

No. Kelsey is an Independent Contractor licensed by the state of Minnesota. She conducts her synergistic microblading business here at the Coon Rapids Simonson's for the convenience of guests. She is self-insured, collects payment for her services, maintains the required records, and manages any service-related questions or challenges. One exception is her appointment calendar. Simonson's will be managing Kelsey Anderson's appointments (booking/cancellations/reminder calls).

3) **What are the five (5) different Microblading services that can be booked and what is the fee?**

Services must be booked by calling into the salon and speaking with a Guest Service Representative. At this time Kelsey's appointments are not online bookable.

- a) Initial Microblading appointment (includes consultation) – 1.5 hours (\$400)
- b) Blade & Shade appointment – 2.5 hours (\$500)
- c) 8-10 week touch-up appointment – 1 hour (\$100)
- d) Additional touch-ups (up to one year) – 1 hour (\$150)
- e) Retouch (1-2 years from initial appointment) – 1.5 hours (\$300)

4) **In what instances (if any) can Microblading NOT be performed?**

- a) Guests who have consumed alcohol or caffeine in the last 24 hours
- b) Guests who are currently pregnant or breast feeding
- c) Guests who have ever taken Accutane
- d) Guests with any of the following skin conditions, will not be a candidate for microblading
  - i) Very oily skin and/or large pores on the face
  - ii) Keloid scars or unhealed scars of any kind on or around brow area
  - iii) Burns, moles, or pimples on the brow area
  - iv) Generalized skin conditions such as rashes, blisters, Eczema, or Psoriasis
- e) Guests using any of the following
  - i) Blood thinning medications
  - ii) Retin-A and/or Renova
- f) Guests with any of the following health issues
  - i) Thyroid issues
  - ii) Diabetes
  - iii) Cancer
  - iv) HIV/AIDS
  - v) Hepatitis
  - vi) Poor blood circulation
  - vii) Epilepsy or other disorder that may cause someone to experience seizures

5) **Are there any side effects?**

Possible side effects include:

- a) Pink/redness around brow area
- b) Light swelling
- c) Darkening of the area
- d) Tenderness/Stinging
- e) Scabbing (strokes may appear light, grey, and blurry until fully healed after a few weeks)

6) **What medications (if any) need to be stopped before having Microblading done?**

Blood thinning medications, Retin-A, Renova, all vitamins and fish oil should be stopped 48 hours prior to appointment.

7) **How long does Microblading typically last?**

This is a semi-permanent procedure with varying results averaging 12 -24 months before a touchup may be needed.
